(Arrival/departure in Montreal, visas, hotel parking information, weather in June)

Visas

ARRIVAL AT MONTREAL AIRPORT

- The first conference session will begin at 13.30 on Friday, 14 June. In order to take advantage of a
 complimentary shared transfer to the hotel, you are asked to arrange a flight that arrives at Montreal
 Airport no later than 10.30am on Friday, 14 June.
- Where flight schedules require arrival on Thursday, 13 June, accommodation will be available from Thursday, 13 June and an informal dinner, hosted by Canadian Ditchley, will be provided that evening.
 Please communicate your date of arrival via the accompanying Conference Registration Form at your earliest convenience.
- Shared airport transfers will be provided on Thursday, 13 June and on Friday, 14 June. The distance to the hotel is approximately 80 mi/125 km, and the transfer should take approximately 90 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.
- Confirmation of these shared transfers will be provided nearer the time, once we have received participants' flight arrival times.
- If you should miss the transfer, or arrive late, a private taxi-style Sedan car service to the hotel will cost approximately CAD \$350 + taxes + service.

• Customs and Immigration:

If your flight originates outside Canada or the United States and you take a connecting flight to reach Montreal, you will have to clear Canadian customs in the connecting city. DEPARTURES FROM MONTREAL

On Sunday, 16 June we will provide shared transfers to Montreal airport following the end of the conference, both before lunch and after lunch, depending on your flight departure time. Please refer to the programme for details.

Check-out time at the hotel is 12 noon. If you are leaving the hotel after that time, please arrange with the Reception Desk to have your luggage stored until your departure.

Please arrange a flight from Montreal airport leaving no earlier than 3.15pm on Sunday, 16 June in order to allow for travel time from the hotel to the airport, plus two hours for checking in (but please check your own airline's specific requirements).

PARKING

For guests planning to drive, the hotel offers Valet parking for \$39 per day plus taxes. It includes unlimited inand-out privileges. Charging stations are available for Teslas and other electric vehicles.

WEATHER

The average temperature in Montreal in June is 18° C, with highs of 23° C at midday. Temperatures drop to an average low of 12° C after dark. The weather can be showery, so consider bringing a raincoat.
